



# South Coast & Tablelands Region Jamboree 2023 – “Turn Back Time”



The 41<sup>st</sup> South Coast and Tablelands Region Jamboree will be held at the Cobargo Showground on the Long Weekend of the 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

## Campsites

1. Units **are strongly encouraged** to combine into Jamboree Size or similar sized groups (36 Scouts and 4 – 6 Leaders), whether on a District Basis or larger Units hosting smaller ones.
2. Common catering is recommended within Units and the supply of equipment distributed.
3. Sites **will require** rope fencing to be erected for the duration of the camp. An average campsite size is 30m X 30m site which will need 120m of fencing materials (rope & pickets).
4. Units are also required to erect a suitable Gateway along the Jamboree Theme (**80s/90s – “Turn Back Time”**).
5. All Units should bring 2-3 20L Water Containers – Taps are within **reasonable** walking distance from Campsites.
6. The SC&T Region Jamboree will not permit **any** campfire near a campsite. The JOC may organise a communal campfire, depending on environmental and fire regulations.

## First Aid

1. Each Unit site is to have a suitable, well stocked and in date First Aid Kit.
2. Each Unit is to also have a qualified Adult to act as a Unit First Aider. While a HQ First Aid Officer with comfortable observation facilities will be available as in years past, Unit First Aiders should be the first point of contact for Scouts to seek FIRST Aid, particularly out of activity session times.

## Major Activities for 2023

The following Major Activities have been planned for the SC&T 41<sup>st</sup> Jamboree.

## Unit Activities

Each Unit is also required to organise a ‘Unit Activity’ which will run as additional activities throughout the Jamboree. The activity should be themed and will also require a risk assessment to be completed and uploaded with the “Unit Activity Registration”. Please ensure leaders assisting with this activity have this nominated as part of the ScoutEvent Registration.

## Combined Dinner

A combined dinner is planned for Sunday night. Units are recommended to plan a meal that is easy to transport in bulk (to serve at the tables), or individually (collect from Unit site). We plan to have Units eating in proximity to their allocated campsites.
