All attendees must approach the registration table on arrival to have their names marked off. Once parked Joeys must then proceed under parent supervision to the Parade Ground, where they can get their Name Tags for the day.

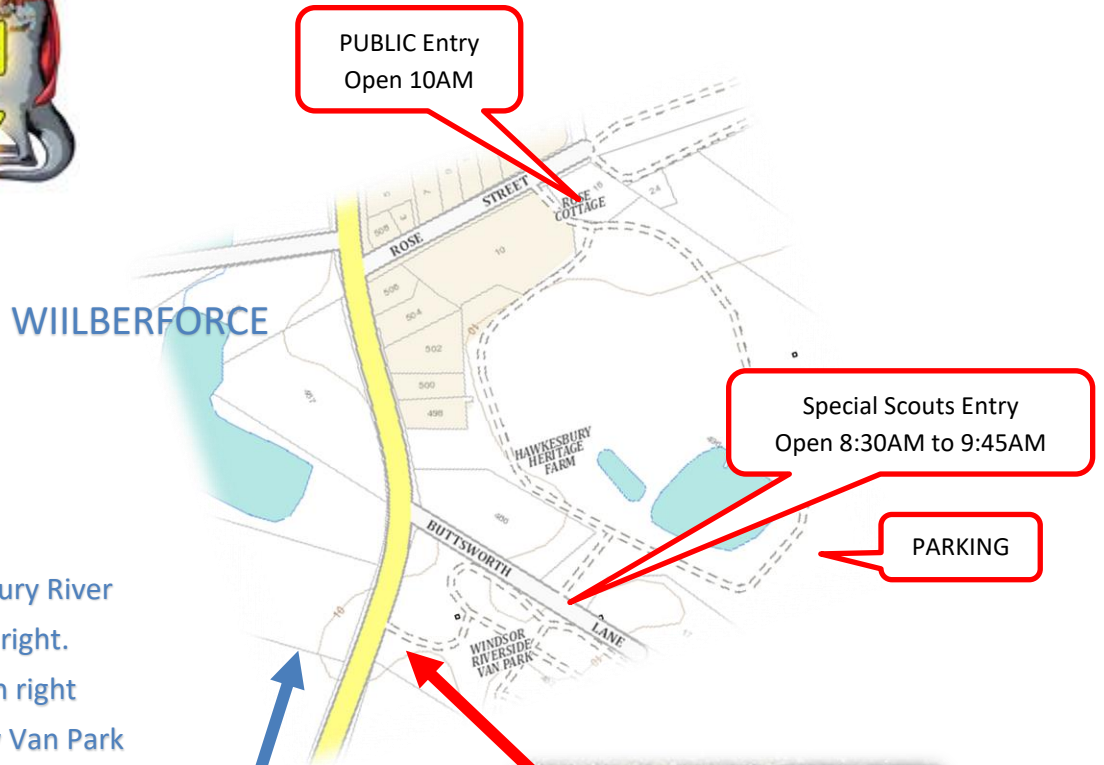
